2021–2022 Program Year Inquiry

The applications for the current California Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Title II: Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (WIOA, Title II: AEFLA) grant cycle covered the three program years between July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2023. Responses to this inquiry will notify the Adult Education Office (AEO) of any current or expected changes that have occurred since the grant application was submitted; and allow us to finish preparing for the year two of the grant cycle.

Section 1: Continuing Programs


