

New Features to the Interactive Fact Sheets

1. Regional Demographics

- Click to Filter. Drill-down into your regional demographic data by clicking on the AT-A-GLANCE icons on the Regional Demographic tab. Click once to filter; click again to remove. You can even filter by multiple elements at once.
- Improved Natural Language Data Element Descriptions. Text boxes that appear when hovering over charts and graphics are easier to read and include statewide percentages for comparison.
- Regional Map now shows pins for each member agency

2. NEW Labor Market Outlook Tab

- Peruse ten-year projections for job openings by industry and occupation by the counties covered by your consortium region. Maps show overlap between boundaries, allowing for easy filtering by counties served.
- Filter occupations with most job openings and fastest growing occupations by entry-level education, typical on-the-job training, work experience required, median hourly wages.
- See how the cost-of-living in your region compares to federal poverty levels by learning about the California Self-Sufficiency standard

3. NEW Job Openings by Median Wage

- Explore the relationship between projected occupational needs and median wages using this interactive tool. Visualizations showing job openings by major occupational groups, individual occupations, and median wages quickly identify which sectors lead to sustainable wages and long-term employment—as well as those that do not.

4. NEW Regional Demographic Maps

- Explore regional needs for adult education services using interactive maps by region, county, and zip (postal) code. Zoom out to see how your consortium region compares to your neighbors and the state.
